

VBC Club COI Update Request Process

2024-2025

As a Member Club of Volleyball BC the Club is able to receive coverage through our insurance as a benefit of Membership. All of VBC Clubs in Good Standing are eligible for insurance coverage for all sanctioned events and activities and receive a copy of the annual Certificate of Insurance (COI) from Volleyball BC. The annual COI lists all registered member clubs of VBC and contains a list of all the venues and facilities that are used by our Clubs and VBC to provide volleyball activities to registered participants. The COI can be updated throughout the season to add additional venues and facilities and governing bodies as needed.

How to Request an update to the COI:

- 1. Once you have completed registration as a Club with VBC and been confirmed as a Club in Good Standing you will receive a copy of the VBC COI.
 - a. Please review the COI to ensure that it includes the venues and facilities and government bodies you need identified in the list.
 - b. Review the COI to ensure that you Club name is there and spelt correctly
- 2. If you need to request a new facility, venue or school district etc. be added to the COI please complete the following steps.
 - a. Confirm from the facility the name that <u>must</u> be listed on the COI.
 - i. There are instances where the name that is on the facility or venue is not the proper name of the facility for insurance purposes.
 - ii. You should ask the facility contact to confirm how they want their facility reflected on the COI.
 - b. Send an email to <u>members@volleyballbc.org</u> and include the following information:
